Dubois County- advice for sensitive populations*

Patoka Reservoir	Bluegill	Up to 7	8 ounces per week (1 meal/week)
	Carp	23+	2 ounces per week (1 meal/month)
	Freshwater Drum	Up to 16	8 ounces per week (1 meal/week)
Patoka River	Buffalo Species	21+	0
	Carp	ALL	2 ounces per week (1 meal/month)
	Carpsucker Species	14+	0
	Channel Catfish	Up to 14	8 ounces per week (1 meal/week)
	White Crappie	Up to 9	8 ounces per week (1 meal/week)
	Wiper	25+	0

*Sensitive populations include: pregnant or nursing women, women that will become pregnant, and children under 6 years of age. These consumers should use caution when eating some types of sportfish.

**The maximum amount for adults to eat is determined by fishing location, species and fish length. For instance, if you eat the maximum amount of one species during a week, you should not eat any other fish which has a consumption limitation until the following week. Example - if you eat the limit (4 ounces) of a 20 inch long Carp from the Easy Catch River, then you should not eat any other sportfish from the list until the following week.
