LaGrange County- advice for sensitive populations*

Fish (Plato) Lake	Golden Redhorse	Up to 18	8 ounces per week (1 meal/week)
	White Sucker	Up to 19	8 ounces per week (1 meal/week)
Lake Shishewana	Carp	30+	0
Lake of the Woods	Bluegill	Up to 6	8 ounces per week (1 meal/week)
Olin Lake	Carp	ALL	2 ounces per week (1 meal/month)
	Rainbow Trout	Up to 15	8 ounces per week (1 meal/week)
Oliver Lake	Carp	ALL	8 ounces per week (1 meal/week)
Pigeon River	Hornyhead Chub	Up to 6	8 ounces per week (1 meal/week)
	Rock Bass	Up to 8	8 ounces per week (1 meal/week)

*Sensitive populations include: pregnant or nursing women, women that will become pregnant, and children under 6 years of age. These consumers should use caution when eating some types of sportfish.

**The maximum amount for adults to eat is determined by fishing location, species and fish length. For instance, if you eat the maximum amount of one species during a week, you should not eat any other fish which has a consumption limitation until the following week. Example - if you eat the limit (4 ounces) of a 20 inch long Carp from the Easy Catch River, then you should not eat any other sportfish from the list until the following week.
