Noble County- advice for sensitive populations*

| Henderson Lake | Carp | 17+ | 0 |
| | Black Crappie | Up to 8 | 8 ounces per week (1 meal/week) |
| Skinner Lake | Bluegill | Up to 7 | 8 ounces per week (1 meal/week) |
| | Carp | Up to 25 | 8 ounces per week (1 meal/week) |
| | Largemouth Bass | Up to 10 | 8 ounces per week (1 meal/week) |
| | Yellow Bullhead | Up to 11 | 8 ounces per week (1 meal/week) |
| | Black Bullhead | Up to 13 | 8 ounces per week (1 meal/week) |
| Sylvan Lake | Black Crappie | Up to 10 | 8 ounces per week (1 meal/week) |
| | Bluegill | Up to 8 | 8 ounces per week (1 meal/week) |
| | Carp | ALL | 0 |
| | Largemouth Bass | Up to 12 | 8 ounces per week (1 meal/week) |
| | Northern Pike | Up to 28 | 8 ounces per week (1 meal/week) |
| | Walleye | Up to 18 | 8 ounces per week (1 meal/week) |
| | White Sucker | Up to 15 | 8 ounces per week (1 meal/week) |

*Sensitive populations include: pregnant or nursing women, women that will become pregnant, and children under 6 years of age. These consumers should use caution when eating some types of sportfish.

**The maximum amount for adults to eat is determined by fishing location, species and fish length. For instance, if you eat the maximum amount of one species during a week, you should not eat any other fish which has a consumption limitation until the following week. Example - if you eat the limit (4 ounces) of a 20 inch long Carp from the Easy Catch River, then you should not eat any other sportfish from the list until the following week.
